Please review the information below for highlights of important instructions on your camper's medications. You will find complete information on the Frequently Asked Questions pages.

BRAND VS GENERIC

Our pharmacy will dispense generic medications unless otherwise specified by your physician with the words "Dispense As Written" specifically written/indicated on the prescription. It is your responsibility to confirm the prescription is written correctly before submission to the pharmacy.

OVER-THE-COUNTER (OTC) MEDICATIONS

We must have authorization from your camper's physician for all over-the-counter medications, vitamins and supplements. Authorization can be in the form of prescription or via the Over-the-Counter Authorization form. Gummies will be packaged in an appropriate method based on the judgment of the packaging pharmacist to ensure a safe and efficient method is used. Alternatives are recommended and available on the Gummy Alternatives link.

CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES

All Controlled Substances must be written on an original prescription and mailed to our pharmacy, or sent directly to our pharmacy via E-Script (Electronic Prescription). They may NOT be faxed.

Please provide two (2) separate prescriptions if your camper is staying more than thirty (30) days. We must have one (1) prescription for each thirty (30) day supply needed.

Your doctor should post-date prescriptions for Controlled Substances with a date thirty (30) days before the camper's session begins. For example, if your camper's session begins on 06/23, the prescription should be dated 05/25. If a second prescription is necessary (greater than 30 days at camp) the second prescription should be dated 30 days later. In our example, 06/23.

Families with NY doctors – As of March 27, 2016 all prescriptions should be sent via Electronic Prescription (E-Script). For non-controlled substances, and Over-The-Counter items, please have your doctor send prescriptions in as soon as possible. For controlled substance prescriptions, please make your camper's doctor is aware that we will require their office to send the Electronic Prescription (E-Script) within 30 days of the start of camp.

REFILLS

If your camper is staying more than thirty (30) days, please make sure your camper's physician includes at least one (1) refill on the prescription before it is sent to our pharmacy. Most non-controlled prescriptions can be written with refills. All controlled substances will require a second prescription. Please follow up with your prescriber to ensure that the 2nd prescription has been sent to the pharmacy.

Do not refill your camper's medication while they are attending camp, as this will cause your insurance company to reject our claim and **you will be responsible for the full cost of the medication.**

INHALERS/ALLERGY

If your child needs an inhaler, allergy medication, or EpiPen, the doctor should provide an Action Plan with dosage and detailed usage when medication is needed based on symptoms.
